3. Parcels over 25kg and up to 40kg cubic weight (maximum 25kg dead weight) will require a second label to match first label.
4. Add an excess label for each additional 5kg to 25kg.

Please note: Maximum length is 2m for parcels to grey, white and pink zones.

National pricing guide

1. Find your destination and identify the coloured zone.
2. Select the correct coloured label for first 5kg.
3. Parcels over 25kg and up to 40kg cubic weight (maximum 25kg dead weight) will require a second label to match first label.
4. Add an excess label for each additional 5kg to 25kg.
5. Effective 1 October 2018 – no manual labels available.
